

“Ride it Out” Grand Opening Event with Trailside Tavern and Patio’s COVID-19 Preparedness Plan

We will monitor and identify sick workers and encourage them to stay home if they report or show symptoms of COVID:

- We will screen every employee/volunteer at the start of the event with a health questionnaire.
- If symptoms are shown, employee/volunteer will be sent home and encouraged to get tested.
- We will make efforts to protect the privacy of the staff and volunteers.

We will make every effort to respect social distancing where possible:

- Attendance size is limited to no more than 100 presold tickets.
- Staff, volunteers, and guests are encouraged to be outside as much as possible – with a large patio in the back of the Trailside Tavern this should be easy to do.
- We have identified key places to set up our event items to ensure the maximum amount of distance while guests and staff are walking through.
- If guests are within 6ft during the event, face coverings will be recommended until seated at their tables with food and/or drink.

We will encourage hygiene:

- Hand sanitizer is placed at the registration table, at the bar, and other various high traffic areas. Staff, volunteers, and guests are encouraged to use it as much as possible.
- Staff are encouraged to wash their hands frequently for at least 20 seconds with soap and water.
- Face coverings will be available, for those who need, during the event for guests and staff.

All staff and volunteers will be well trained in these procedures and efforts will be made to encourage their implementation while we are holding this event.
